4. **C) Will** — Will you is a standard way of asking for help.
5. **B) won't** — A promise not to do something takes won't.
6. **A) will** — Will never changes form and is followed by the base verb.
7. **B) I'll make you a coffee.** — An offer made in the moment uses will.
8. **C) will probably** — Adverbs like probably go after will and before the main verb.
9. **B) won't** — Won't also expresses a refusal, not just a future fact.
